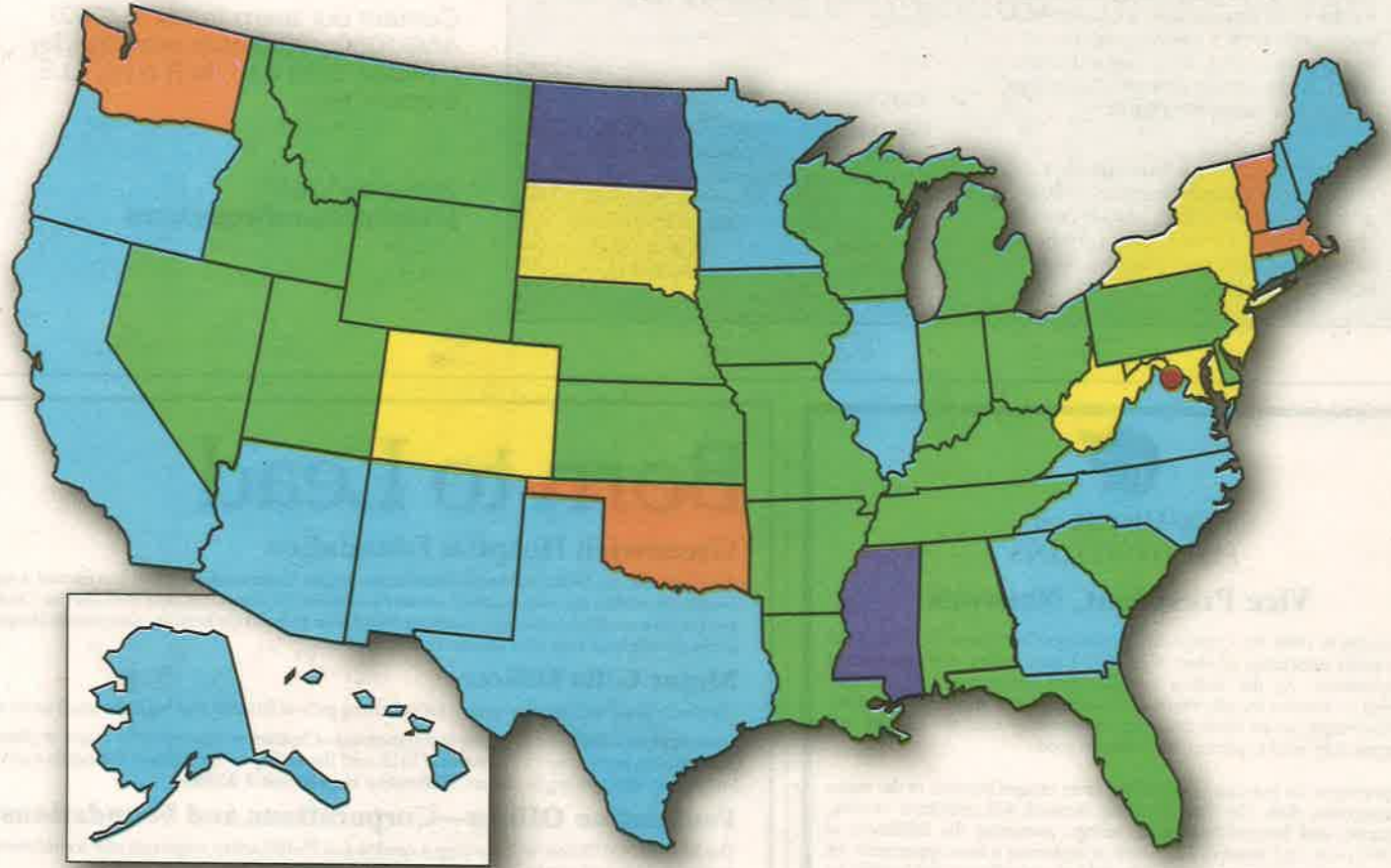


# Ranking Online Generosity in the States

Donors in the District of Columbia gave much more online per capita than those in any of the 50 states, according to donation totals provided to *The Chronicle* by the online-giving processors Blackbaud, Network for Good, and PayPal. Among states, residents in Oklahoma gave the most per capita, followed closely by Massachusetts and Vermont.
